The Endocrinologist will be responsible for the diagnosis, treatment and monitoring of patients as well as effectively managing and coordinating care. You will provide care by examining and treating patients as necessary and by communicating with the patient, family and other healthcare providers to build a portfolio of patient data and a case history. The Endocrinologist will order and evaluate diagnostic and laboratory testing as needed and other duties will be assigned as necessary.

Working closely with the principal practitioner, you will be responsible for monitoring indicators, audits and endocrinology outcomes; suggesting the necessary resources to provide an effective endocrinology service; collaborate with other specialists with an emphasis on holistic care for the individual and communicate between the community and specialist colleagues to support coordination of care; assess diagnose and treat endocrine diseases and evaluating clinical data and assessing status, on patients referred to the service.

*Candidates must be:*

- An American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) Certified Endocrinologist or a member of the Royal College of Physicians of the United Kingdom (MRCP) or Canada
- A graduate of a two to three-year programme that focuses on metabolism, diabetes and endocrinology training in both inpatient and outpatient settings
- Currently registered with the Medical Council as a specialist in our relevant jurisdiction

- Competency in writing reports and procedural manuals
- Ability to read and analyse medical periodicals and journals
- Computer literate
- Critical thinker
- A well-defined sense of diplomacy, including solid negotiation, conflict resolution, and people management skills
